DISTRIBUTION OF MASKS



Face masks were distributed in the slums of Auto Nagar, Krishnalanka, Poranki, Penamaluru, Nunna especially for the Rag pickers, Sanitary workers at Rural areas.

26th June21 to 29th Jun-21, nearly 1500Peoplewere given a set of 4 Face Masks to cover their face to protect from Corona.



DISTRIBUTION OF DRY RATION



Provisions kits were distributed in the slums of Auto Nagar, Krishnalanka, Poranki, Penamaluru, Nunna areas, particularly for malnourished people.

Dry ration for 1 month supplies were packed and distributed. 10th June21 to 17th Jun-21, nearly 600 families were benefited through Dry Ration.

GROCERIES DISTRIBUTION



During the Second wave of CORONA, all our Management Members of ALC along with our College Faculty members jointly conducted various Care & Support programmes for the sake of unreached Poor with hunger. Food supplies in the form of Dry Ration, Face Masks, Roof protection Tarpaulin Sheets were supplied to the Yanadi Tribes at Penamaluru, Poranki, PorankiDonka road, Prabhu Nagar, Krishnalanka, Pathapadu of Vijayawada Urban and Rural. And also dry ration was given to the Outreach frontline workers who are working in the Slums of Vijayawada. Nearly 400 families received above help through ALC and rescued from hunger due to CORONA second wave in the month of May-June 2021.



MEDICAL KITS DISTRIBUTION



Medical kits were supplied to the Corona affected people, in Christurajpuram, Gangireduladibba, Arul Nagar areas. Provided 1200 Medical kits for the miserable people who cannot afford to buy Medicines at this peak time and helped to save many lives. (15th June to 23 June 21)
