2.5.3 - IT integration and reforms in the examination procedures and processes including Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) have brought in considerable improvement in the Examination Management System (EMS) of the Institution

The college examination centre serves as the main body in scheduling, conducting the examination as per the guidelines framed by the UGC. Adherence to stringent rules and regulations prepares the question papers, evaluates and declares the results to the students as per the norms of Krishna University. Choice based credit system is adopted to cater students the opportunity to choose the courses among the core, elective or skill based courses. Continuous Internal Assessment is done to evaluate the student based on their performance in mid examination twice in a semester for each course, periodical assignments/tests/quizzes etc. in order to make them engaged with the subject content throughout the semester. A detailed scheme of evaluation is prepared by internal subject / course experts to maintain uniformity in the evaluation among the evaluators. External subject experts prepare the question papers as per the scheme and also evaluate them to maintain equilibrium in the standards of evaluation. Periodical update of internal and external marks in the college website to uphold personal verification, revaluation of marks, announcement of supplementary examinations and timely publication of results & issuing necessary certificates in time. Students with the required attendance percentage are only allowed to take the exams in both theory and lab.
