HigherEducation for Persons with Special Needs (HEPSN)- a UGC initiative for the benefit of differently-abled students, implements initiatives to provide a supportive environment for the academic growth of physically and visually challenged students by organizing sensitization and motivational programmes, training in computer-aided learning, providing scribes' services during examinations, and connecting the NGOs / Governmental agencies to the visually challenged students, for obtaining necessary support. Our college has a total number of 30 differently-abled students - number of Students with visual Impairments: 19 Number of Students with Orthopedic challenges; 10 Number of Students with Hearing challenges : 01 pursuing different courses in the current academic year. Dr.G. Sahaya Baskaran, Dept. of Physics, is the coordinator, for this HEPSN programme. The support to these students is provided through NGOs like Help the Blind Foundation-Hong Kong, Enable India-Bangalore, Youth4Jobs-Hyderabad, and government agencies such as Department of Disabled Welfare and Senior Citizens, Govt. of A.P. and AP State Skill Development Corporation (APSSDC).
