Action Taken Report

Having had the feedback from the Students through the Google forms, the feedback Committee made a thorough analysis and further in Consultation with Fr. Principal and members of the Management, the Committee chalked out a list issues and the Problems to be tackled to initiate.

ALUMNI Feedback on Curriculum

After Alumni feedback on Curriculum, the majority of the students felt happy regarding curriculum. A few of the students expressed their dissatisfaction regarding hostel facilities. To convince them they were assured that facilities like washing machines, more hostel rooms, drinking water, WIFI facilities will be provided based on conditions. The management is taking the necessary action needed for hostel facilities. Most of the students are satisfied about the syllabus which is opt to the global and national needs. Regarding syllabus Principal had a meeting with head of the departments and had revised the syllabus wherever necessary. The majority of the students felt confident after the conduct of continuous internal assessments. Overall, the maximum number of students felt happy and gave a positive feedback about the college.

EMPLOYERS FEEDBACK on Curriculum

After Employers feedback on Curriculum, the major part of the employers felt that the content of the course is very relevant to employability. Majority of them agreed that the curriculum is open to new ideas and learning new technologies. Regarding syllabus Principal had a meeting with head of

the departments and had revised the syllabus wherever necessary. Overall, most of the employers felt that the curriculum plays a crucial role in improving the innovative thinking.

Feedback from Parents on Curriculum

After taking the feedback from parents on curriculum, we observed that majority of the parents felt happy about the syllabus offered in the program. A few of them suggested that the curriculum needs to be designed and developed to enhance their personal and professional skills for the employment. For that purpose, more career guidance programs will be introduced to guide the students for getting jobs. A vast majority of the parents felt happy that the curriculum covers all the necessary skills, knowledge, values and ethics. It is observed that there are minor portion of parents who felt that the seminar hall facilities need to be improved. For this, more seminar halls will be provided to have effective learning for the students. Few of the parents felt unhappy regarding restroom facilities. In order to rectify this, more rest room facilities will be provided for boys and girls students separately in each floor.

Regarding the academic discipline, almost all the parents felt happy.

FEEDBACK FROM STUDENTS on Curriculum

After students' feedback on Curriculum, most of the students felt happy about the curriculum for developing skill, employability and entrepreneurship. Majority of them agreed that there is a wide scope for research in the course. Maximum number of the students are satisfied the teaching with methodology. The major of the student are happy with the library and lab facilities. A few of the students felt that there is a need to improve the financial assistance to the poor students. The college had introduced a new entrepreneurship program in the college hours. For economically poor students management scholarships are given to the students. All unanimously voiced that they are being encouraged to participate in sports and cultural activities.
