

### **Admission Policy for Reservations**

Andhra Loyola College in Vijayawada, as a Christian Minority College, has a unique admission policy that combines reservations for specific categories with a commitment to merit-based admissions. Here's a detailed description of the admission policy for reservations at Andhra Loyola College for offline admissions:

### **Reservation Categories:**

### **Christian Minority Quota:**

The College reserves a certain percentage of seats for Christian students as per its Minority status.

Applicants under this quota must provide valid proof of their Christian identity, such as baptism certificates or letters from church authorities.

# Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST), Other Backward Classes (OBC):

As mandated by government guidelines, Andhra Loyola College reserves seats for students belonging to SC, ST, and OBC categories. The percentage of seats reserved for each category is determined by government regulations.

### **Economically Weaker Sections (EWS):**

In accordance with government directives, the College also reserves seats for students from economically weaker sections. Applicants in the EWS category must provide income certificates or relevant documents as proof.

### Physically Handicapped (PH) or Persons with Disabilities (PWD):

The College allocates seats for students with physical disabilities or special needs, as per disability reservation norms. Candidates in this category need to submit disability certificates or medical documents for verification.
