


Won 4 Krishna University Inter-Collegiate Championships in Athletics, Basketball, Softball, and Boxing in the Men's category.





Moreover, our

students have achieved numerous individual prizes throughout the academic year.







Academic Fests:

World Ozone Day - Drawing Competition: The Department of Chemistry organized a Drawing Competition on "Causes for Depletion of Ozone Layer" for all Degree Students on 16th September 2019 to commemorate World Ozone Day. A Poster Presentation Competition on "The Importance of Non-Ozone Depleting Substances in The Protection of Ozone Layer" was also conducted.





Bemus 2019: The Department of Commerce hosted Bemus 2019, a National Level Commerce Fest on 16th and 17th September 2019. Prof. K. Hemachandra Reddy, Chairman of AP State Council of Higher Education, inaugurated the event. It saw participation from 44 colleges across Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, Kerala, Telangana, and West


Women's Day Celebrations 2020: The Women's Cell organized Women's Day Celebrations 2020 on 9th March.




