The meeting started with a prayer by Rev Fr.Dr.M.Sagayaraj, SJ, Correspondent, invoking God's blessings for the successful conduct of the proceedings. Rev Fr.S.Melchior, SJ, Vice-Principal, welcomed the members.

Dr.CH.Srinivasu, Secretary-Academic Activities, initiating the proceedings, placed the Agenda before the Council.

The Secretary-Academic Activities requested Rev Fr.Dr.G.A.P.Kishore, SJ, Principal and Chairman, Academic Council, to present the Academic Review for the year 2018-2019. Fr.Principal, in his Brief Review of Academic Activities for the Academic Year 2018-2019 highlighted the following:

The Academic Council ratified the results.

Under any other matter, Fr.Principal moved the following three Resolutions and sought the Academic Council's approval:

- 1. It is resolved to start two new Undergraduate Programmes under RUSA Career Hubs viz.,
 - B.Sc., (Mathematics, Statistics, Computer Science with Big Data Analytics) &

It is also resolved to constitute an Expert Subject Committee to design the Structure and Syllabi of these two Programmes.

- 2. It is resolved to start two Undergraduate Apprenticeship-embedded Programmes of the Ministry of Human Resources Development, Government of India, viz., B.B.A., Logistics Management and B.B.A., Retail Management from the Academic Year 2019-2020.
- 3. It is resolved to start three new Diploma Courses in Artificial Intelligence, Big Data Analytics and Internet of Things from the Academic Year 2019-2020 under RUSA Career Hubs.

The Academic Council unanimously approved the Resolutions.

Later, Secretary-Academic Activities invited the members to make their general observations and suggestions.

Sr.Mercy, Educationist, welcomed introduction of more employability-oriented new Courses combined with Internship and Industrial training.

Sri D.Ramakrishna, Industrial Expert, congratulated the administration on getting sizeable funds from different Government Agencies for further promotion of Science, Technology, Research, and Enhancing Quality and Excellence in the College. He suggested making the Syllabi more practical and application-oriented, in tune with the latest advancements, with the objective of preparing students for the global market. He further suggested greater participation of Faculty Members in international seminars and workshops across the world.

Fr.Dr.Francis Xavier, SJ, Educationist, suggested sending Faculty Members to Jesuit Universities abroad to undergo Short Term Courses/Training Programmes in order to enable them to acquire international exposure to the global educational aspects.

The meeting concluded with Dr.G.Srinivasa Rao, Coordinator, IQAC, proposing a
