Later, the Secretary-Academic Activities invited the Heads/Coordinators of both the U.G. and P.G. Departments, which proposed changes in their Syllabi only, to present the Resolutions of their respective Boards of Studies for the Council's ratification.

Under any other matter, Fr.Principal moved the following Resolutions and sought the Academic Council's approval:

1. It was proposed and decided, at a meeting of the College Officials held on 09.11.2020, to commence the Academic Year 2020-2021 with Offline Classes for the fresh batch of students on 16<sup>th</sup> November 2020, for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Year Degree Students on 4<sup>th</sup> January 2021 and for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Year Degree Students on 7<sup>th</sup> December 2020 in pursuance of the UGC Guidelines communicated vide its Lr.No.D.O.14-8/2020 (CPP-III), dt.05.11.2020 dated 5<sup>th</sup> November 2020 for Physical Re-opening of the Colleges post Lockdown due to Covid-19 Pandemic.

The Academic Council gave its post facto approval and ratified the resolution unanimously.

2. It is proposed to have one Online and one Offline Mid Semester Test with Objective-type Questions for Fifteen Marks and Five Marks for Oral Assessment for the Online Mid Semester Test.

The Academic Council unanimously approved the Resolution.

In his closing remarks, Fr.Principal stated that this Academic Council meeting will be the last official meeting for him in view of his superannuation on 31<sup>st</sup> January 2021 and thanked the University Nominees, the Officials of Krishna University, all the officials of the College including HoDs/Coordinators, Deans, Members of the Faculty, members of Andhra Loyola College Alumni Association for their highly cooperative and supportive role in improving the academic atmosphere of the College and development of the institution during his tenure.

3. It is resolved to start two Additional Sections in B.Com., Computers with an Intake of 60 (sixty) each.

4. It is resolved to start the following two new Certificate Courses by ALC-JKC to III UG Students during the V and VI Semesters from the academic year 2021-2022:

(i) Communication and Soft Skills Certificate Course and (ii) Essential Employability Skills Certificate Course

The Academic Council unanimously approved the four Resolutions.

Later, the Secretary I/c-Academic Activities, invited the members to offer their observations/suggestions, if any.

Fr.Dr.A.Francis Xavier, SJ, Educationist, suggested organizing Online Guest Lectures for the students of P.G. Chemistry and U.G. Food Technology courses with Resource Persons drawn from reputed intuitions such as the Central University, Central Food Technological Research Institute (CFTRI) or Laila Impex.

Sri Rama Krishna, Industrial Expert, suggested making the Syllabi more practical and application-oriented in tune with the latest advancements with online tools available in order to prepare students for the global market with greater access to gainful employment. In this connection, he observed that faculty keeping themselves continuously abreast of the latest emerging topics of their respective disciplines and equipping themselves with both the theoretical and practical expertise is of paramount importance and said that it would afford the students cutting-edge knowledge.

With the foregoing deliberations and ratifications by the Academic Council, the meeting concluded with Rev.Fr.Dr.S.Melchoir, SJ, Vice-Principal (Degree), proposing a Vote of Thanks.
